Why do we need your help?

- Litter is unsightly - it destroys the aesthetics of our beautiful parks and City.
- Litter is expensive – we hire seasonal workers to pick up litter and empty trashcans for five months each year and still we cannot keep up with the problem.
- Your help each spring, summer, and fall will save tax dollars and allow maintenance workers to devote time and effort to other important projects.
- A litter free community is inviting to visitors, prospective new citizens, and businesses.

What are the adopter's responsibilities?

- Begin park clean up in April. Throughout the summer and fall maintain adopted area on a weekly basis.
- Assist with litter pick up, flowerbed weeding, raking leaves, and twig/small branch pickup.
- Do not attempt to remove homeless sites or suspected toxic/hazardous substances, needles, sharp objects or objects too heavy or large to move – note the approximate location and notify Public Works.
- Leave filled garbage bags in the existing garbage cans or right next to them.

- Schedule your pick up time to get garbage bags, rakes, and disposable gloves.
- Call when clean- up is completed so staff can promptly pick up garbage bags the following day.
