




40th Avenue South Corridor IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

The City of Moorhead is making improvements to 40th Avenue South between 8th Street and 20th Street in 2026. This roadway is an important connection to residential areas, schools, parks, local businesses, and churches. This project will make 40th Avenue South safer and more accessible for all road users, including drivers, pedestrians, and bicyclists.

The goal of this project is to:

- Enhance safety, especially for pedestrians
- Reduce speeding and improve traffic flow
- Maintain pavement and prepare for future growth
