**CERTIFICATION OF COMPLIANCE WITH THE
MINNESOTA WORKER'S COMPENSATION LAW**

Title 2. BUSINESS AND LICENSE REGULATIONS

Chapter 2. AMUSEMENTS

Article C. THEATER

2-2C-1: LICENSE REQUIRED:

No person shall operate a moving picture show or theater or show without a license therefor. (Ord. 51; amd. Ord. 91; 1967 Code §52.08)

2-2C-2: APPLICATION FOR LICENSE:

Application for such license shall specify the nature of the performances, the name of the owner, the location of the building, the number of exits, seating capacity of building and nature of fire protection. (Ord. 51; amd. Ord. 91; 1967 Code §52.08)

2-2C-3: LICENSE TERM AND FEE:

All licenses granted under this article shall be for a term in accordance with subsection [2-1-6A](#) of this title. The fee for such license is as established by the city's fee schedule. (Ord. 51; amd. Ord. 91; 1967 Code §52.08; Ord. 2007-30, 1-7-2008, eff. retroactive to 1-1-2008)

2-2C-4: NUMBER OF LICENSES:

The number of licenses shall be limited and regulated by the number of inhabitants of the city, as determined by the last state or federal census thereof, so that there shall not be more than one license granted to every five thousand (5,000) inhabitants of the city, or fraction thereof. (Ord. 51; amd. Ord. 91; 1967 Code §52.08)

2-2C-5: FIRE PRECAUTIONS:

The licensee shall cause all exits to be so constructed as to allow the doors of same to open outwards. All buildings in which licenses are granted shall be provided with fire extinguishers, and there shall be maintained over every exit a red incandescent light as well as a sign marked "Exit". All rooms in which moving picture machines are operated shall be so constructed of incombustible material as to render the same absolutely fireproof. (Ord. 51; amd. Ord. 91; 1967 Code §52.08)

2-2C-6: INDECENT SHOWS PROHIBITED:

The licensees shall conduct, maintain and operate their place of business and performances in an orderly manner and shall not allow the exhibition of any lewd, immoral or indecent performances, acts or moving pictures. (Ord. 51; amd. Ord. 91; 1967 Code §52.08)
