The City of Moorhead is seeking art to present to recipients of the City’s “MoorHeart” program that recognizes people who have performed good deeds, service and spirit of neighborliness within our community. The art used to commemorate the Moorhead award since the program began in 2020 is no longer available. The City is seeking proposals from local artists to commission the 2023 MoorHeart award art.

- **VISION**

The vision for the 2023 MoorHeart Award is to develop a single design whether literal or abstract “heart” and speaks to the receiver of appreciation for good deeds, service and a spirit of neighborliness from the City of Moorhead.

- **QUANTITY & TIMELINE**

Two by June 1, 2023; 12 more by August 1, 2023. Additional orders may be requested at a future date.

- **PRICE RANGE**

\$60 - 90 each

- Medium (glass, steel, painting, etching, etc.)
- Technique
- Size
- Unit price for the 14 awards
- Other descriptions to help in the deliberation process

Notice of commission will occur by 4 pm on Friday, May 5, 2023. The first work of art/MoorHeart Award must be delivered to Moorhead City Hall by 4:30 pm on Thursday, June 1, 2023.

Artist must provide a W-9 prior to payment.
