### Exterior

\_\_\_\_ Make house number visible from street \_\_\_\_ Trim trees away from electrical wires



\_\_\_\_ Trim trees away from chimney and remove all pine needles and leaves from roofs, eaves & rain gutters For more information, contact MPS (218) 299-5400

# Heating Equipment & Fireplace

Keep space heaters at least 3 feet away from all combustibles



- \_\_ Replace furnace filters once a year
  \_\_ Clean lint from behind clothes dryer
- \_\_\_ Install a spark screen in front of the fireplace
- \_\_\_\_ Have chimney inspected and cleaned annually
- \_\_\_\_ Install a spark arrester on chimney
- \_\_\_\_ Dispose of ashes in metal containers
- Keep newspapers, other combustibles and clutter away from water heater



#### Electrical

- \_\_\_\_ Avoid overloading electrical circuits
- \_\_\_ Inspect electrical cords and appliances for damage
- \_\_ Do not tack cords to the wall or run them under rugs
- \_\_\_\_ Maintain air space around electrical equipment, such as, TV, VCR, stereo, etc.
- \_\_\_\_Install additional outlets, by a qualified electrician, to avoid using cube taps and extension cords
- \_\_\_\_ If you must use extension cords, use only the kind that have a built-in circuit breaker

#### Flammable Liquids & Hazardous Materials

- \_\_ Limit the amount of chemicals stored
- \_\_\_\_ Dispose of and recycle household hazardous materials properly (see below)
- \_\_\_\_ Store hazardous materials in proper containers with tight- fitting lids and correct identification labels
- \_\_\_ Store hazardous materials away from heat sources
- \_\_\_\_Allow for proper ventilation when using flammable liquids and hazardous materials
- \_\_\_\_Put oily rags in metal containers with tight-fitting lids, not in a pile where they can spontaneously ignite

#### Cooking

- \_\_\_ Never leave cooking unattended
- \_\_\_\_ Cuff sleeves and turn pot handles inward when cooking to avoid bum injuries
- \_\_\_\_ never store combustibles in oven or on top of stove
- When barbequing, move unit away from the house
- \_\_\_\_ Dispose of coals /ashes in metal containers

#### **Smoking Materials & Candles**

\_\_\_\_ Never leave cigarettes or candles unattended



- \_\_\_\_ Purchase and use ashtrays that have the center support feature
- \_\_\_ Empty ashtrays into noncombustible containers only
- \_\_\_ Never smoke in bed
- \_\_ Place candles in noncombustible, sturdy holders
- \_\_\_ Keep matches and Lighters out of reach of children

# Smoke Alarms/Carbon Monoxide Alarms (CO)

- \_\_ Install smoke alarms inside and outside every sleeping area and on every level of your home
- \_\_\_\_Test smoke alarms once a month
- Tip: use a broom handle to reach & push test button Replace smoke alarm batteries once a year
- Tip: use Daylight Savings Time as a reminder Replace smoke alarm units every 10 years
- \_\_\_\_\_ Install CO alarms near sleeping rooms

#### **Fire Extinguishers**

- \_\_\_ Purchase a multipurpose (ABC) extinguisher
- \_\_\_\_ Teach your family how to use a fire extinguisher (Use P.A.S.S.: Pull the pin, Aim, Squeeze, Sweep)
  - Inspect extinguishers annually

# **Develop & Practice A Home Escape Plan**

- \_\_ Develop a home escape plan that includes:
  - Crawling low under smoke
  - Two exits out of every room
- A meeting place outside (tree, mailbox, etc.)
- Practice escape plan with every member
- \_\_\_\_ Teach all family members how to:
  - Dial 9 -1 -1 in an emergency
  - (State your name, location & type of emergency)
- Stop, drop, and roll if clothes catch fire
