

Site Plan Details

Your Site Plan must include:

- property boundaries
- existing structure(s)
 - house
 - garage/shed
- proposed structure(s)
 - o pool
 - pool equipment (filter unit, pump, heater)
 - fence or wall/gates with self-closing and self-latching devices
- existing and proposed impervious surface*
 - driveway
 - walkway
 - o patio
- setbacks to property lines
- easements
- utility locations
- *An impervious surface is any surface that cannot effectively absorb or infiltrate rainfall. (Pools unable to maintain a minimum of 6 inches of depth between top of pool edge and top of water surface are impervious surface.)



** If the site plan is not drawn to scale, please note the square footage of all structures and impervious surfaces.

**All Pools shall comply with Moorhead City Code Chapter 9 - Pools and Minnesota State Building Code.

- Pool location shall be at least 5 feet from property lines in the side or rear yard.
- Permit required for all custom pools, all in-ground pools, and above-ground pools that meet or exceed both 5,000 gallons and 24-inch depth.
 - Must be completely enclosed by a fence or wall measuring at least 4 feet in height. Any
 openings between bottom of fence or wall and ground shall not exceed 4 inches. All gates shall
 be equipped with self-closing and self-latching devices placed at the top of the gate or
 otherwise inaccessible to small children. Fences may be placed directly around the pool area.
