



RECYCLE GUIDE

Drop Sites

ALUMINUM

Rinse.

- Aluminum Cans, Steel or Tin Food Cans
- **NO:** Aluminum Foil, Containers That Held Hazardous Substances, and No Scrap Metal

MAGAZINES

- Magazines and Catalogs
- **NO:** Junk Mail or Phone Books

NEWSPAPER

- Newspaper and Newspaper Inserts
- **NO:** Spiral Phone Books, Shredded Paper, Magazines, or Junk Mail

YARD WASTE

- Leaves and Grass
- **NO:** Branches

CARDBOARD

Flatten All Cardboard.

- Cardboard (Non-Waxed), Beverage & Soda Cases, Cake & Snack Boxes, Pizza Delivery Boxes
- **NO:** Fridge/Freezer or Wax Coated Boxes, Styrofoam or Other Packaging Materials

GLASS

Rinse and Take Caps Off.

- Glass Containers That Contain Food or Beverage Product, All Colored Glass (Brown, Green, and Clear)
- **NO:** Drinking Glasses, Window Glass, Ceramics, or Mirrors

PLASTIC

Rinse and Take Caps Off.

- Berry Containers, Juice Containers, Milk Jugs, Plastic Containers #1-#7, Water Bottles, Yogurt Tubs, Butter Tubs, etc.
- **NO:** Plastic Bags, Plastic/Saran Wrap or Containers That Held Hazardous Substances Such as Motor Oil or Antifreeze
